To Apply:

Each artist/crafter may apply for a single category. Each entry must be accompanied by a non-refundable jury fee of \$20.00. Your booth fee must be included. Your booth fees will be refunded if you are not selected, or if space is depleted before you apply. Please include 3 (three) high-resolution images of your work that accurately represent and reflect your current creations, and 1 (one) photo of your booth at a recent event, 1 (one) photo of the work in progress, along with event name and date. If you place your name and address on the back of each photo, & enclose an SASE, we will make every effort to return all photos to you. Please include descriptions of your work in a short statement; this statement will be included in the jury process. No non-juried items will be allowed. Artist must present work that is in line with the family atmosphere of Tannehill State Park. Any items not meeting this description may be removed at the discretion of Park Administration. Please do not send samples of your work. All persons who may work in your booth must be listed on application.

Application & Fee Deadline:

All applications, jury fees and booth fees must be submitted at time of application. Notification of acceptance/denial will be sent when juried, as received.

Jury Selection: A panel of local artists and crafters, along with Tannehill Administration will jury your art or craft, based on uniqueness, and product excellence. No “purchased for resale” items will be allowed.

Booth Space Information

Booth Space Assignment:

Booth spaces will be assigned by The Tannehill Craft Committee to ensure all Vendors receive optimum placement. All booth assignments are final. If you have special needs, please indicate on your Festival application. Upon Check-in you will receive your space number(s).

Booth Sizes:

Each space is 12 X 12. Vendors must provide tents, tables, display fixtures, chairs, etc. Please bring tent weights and tie down stakes. Tents improperly secured must be removed if weather dictates, and as re-

requested by Tannehill management. **NO OBJECTS, may extend out of the 12 x 12 space, including signs.** You must purchase additional space if needed. All booths are on Natural Terrain; and as such, may be uneven, have tree roots, etc.

We do offer a few booths with electrical service, they will be distributed on a first come first serve basis. Generators are not allowed.

Booth Setup:

Please check in at the Festival/Park office on arrival. You will receive your Vendor Packet at that time. Festival hours will be 9:00 AM till 5:00 PM on Friday and Saturday, and 9:00 AM till 4:00 PM on Sunday. If you have a trailer, you must set up on Thursday, September 20th, between 9:00 and 6:00 PM. All vendors may set up at that time; if you do not have a trailer you may set up Friday, September 21th, between 6:00 AM and 8:00 AM. If you arrive late, you will have to walk your items to your booth. If you cannot set up within the hours permitted, and as required, you will forfeit your space.

Additional Information

This Event is “Rain or Shine”. Please be prepared for inclement weather.

We offer camping in our campsites. September is still a very popular time of year here at Tannehill, and our campsites do fill up. We offer them on a First Come – First Serve basis. In addition to camping we have 6 rental cabins on the property. The cabins can be reserved on a first come first serve basis. There are additional campgrounds in the area, as well as hotels and motels.

The Sweet Shoppe located on the Tannehill Property is a great place to satisfy that sweet tooth, and our own Country Store is a step back to the past. You may buy roasted peanuts, hot coffee, hot chocolate, basic food supplies and many other items, including Tannehill souvenirs.

We will offer security throughout the festival. In addition to our Park Ranger, we will have specified Festival security. However, as at any Festival, if you have items you feel would be more secure in your direct control, please carry those away with you at night.
